Online 'Virtual' Class Policy and Procedures

Virtual After School Sport Club

What schools, parents and students can expect from us:

- All staff leading and delivering online sessions on our behalf are employed, reference checked and have Enhanced DBS checks in place.
- Only staff who usually deliver face to face in schools will be used to deliver these virtual sessions.
- All staff will be suitably qualified and experienced to deliver the activities they are leading.
- All online sessions will be delivered through YouTube live, only those with the link can view. Students will not be able to be seen by other participants and will not be able to make comments during the session.
- During the delivery of all sessions, staff will conduct themselves in accordance with the usual code of conduct and expected professional manner.
- All sessions will have a minimum of two staff present at all times.
- Staff will plan and deliver fun and engaging activities to help keep the children active during this period.

What we expect from participants:

- All participants to arrive promptly at the start of the live session.
- Parents/Guardians to be present (in sight) for the duration of sessions.
- Find a safe space to complete the activity which minimises the risk of injury. Activities will be designed to take place indoors in limited space.
- We encourage children to take part, try their hardest and have fun during the sessions.
